When you see lightning, start counting one, two, three for each second. Continue counting until you hear thunder. Three seconds are about the same as one kilometer. But if you only count one or two seconds before you hear thunder, the storm is very close. Take care.

Many architects and engineers work together as a team to turn the industrial areas into a beautiful, environmentally-friendly home for people.

The buildings are made of natural materials such as wood and stone. Every building has an open area around it, so that sunlight can come through.
