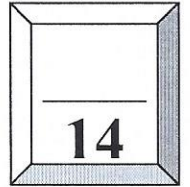

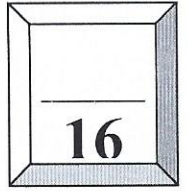

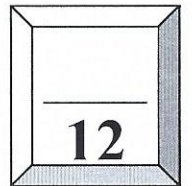
Read the following text carefully then answer the questions below:

Although we still don't know how our sense of smell works, our love of perfume is very old. The Ancient Egyptians used to put perfumed oils in their hair. The oil found in Tutankhamen's tomb was still fragrant when it was opened 2.000 years after he'd been buried there. At feasts in Roman times, white birds with their wings covered in perfume, too flew around the room so that the air was filled **magnificently** with a sweet scent.

In Paris there's a perfume museum called Osmotheque, which has an amazing 1.100 perfumes. Next to the museum, there is a school. Perfumers who make perfumes are taught **there** how to create new fragrances. There are only about 400 of them in the world. To make a single kind of perfume you need between 400 and 500 ingredients, which are often costly.

How do you decide whether a perfume is right for you? First, never buy a perfume that you haven't tried on your skin. What smells nice on a friend may smell terrible on you. Secondly, avoid heat and light. It's important to keep perfumes in a dark place at a temperature of no higher than 15°C.
