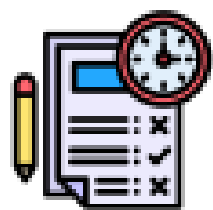
### Exploring Cultures

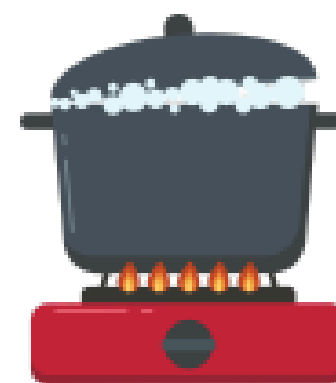
