Most roads in most countries have a speed limit. When driving on these roads, drivers must obey the speed limit. In the U.S., the speed limit on most highways is 65 miles (105 kilometers) per hour. 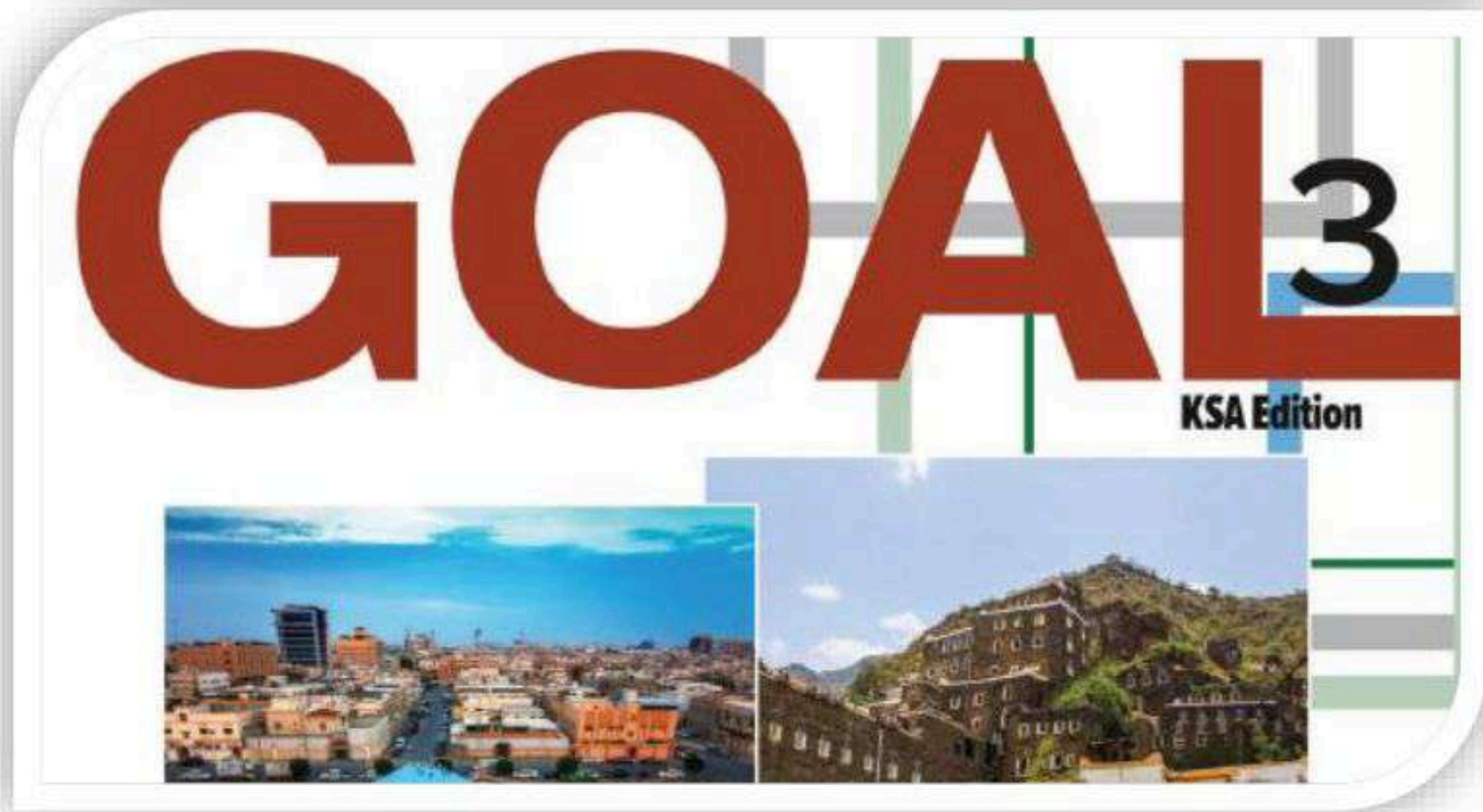
