#### LISTENING

#### **Listening Tip**

Before you listen to someone speak about a topic, you can predict what they will discuss before actually listening. When you predict, you guess what the person will talk about. After you predict, listen to the person speak and ask yourself, "Was the prediction correct?" Predicting helps you to become interested in the topic and it helps you listen for important information.



**LMS** 

Use the present continuous tense when you are talking about an action that is happening right now. The present continuous uses the helping verb "to be" and then a verb ending with -ing. When you write in the present continuous, you must always use the right form of the verb "to be".

Look at the examples from the listening activity. Notice the verbs in bold:



The elephant is taking a sand bath. It's actually being healthy. You see, elephants use sand to stay clean and healthy. Look! It's using its long trunk to throw sand on its head. Elephants need to take sand baths because the sand pushes bugs off their skin. Bugs make the elephants sick because the bugs bite their skin. The elephant uses sand like a cover to keep bugs away!




