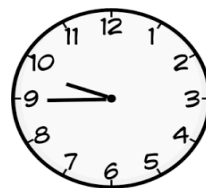

Sami checked again — and there it was!

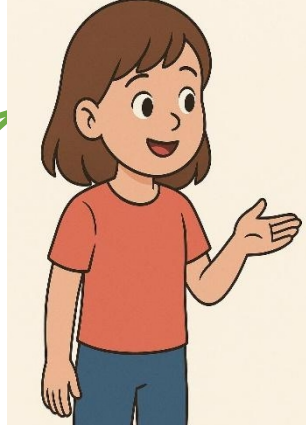
“Oh, that's great!” he said. “I found it!”
