Do you like adventure? Do you enjoy the beauty of nature? Do you like to see wild animals in their natural home? Then come to Costa Rica—a paradise for adventure and nature lovers. The tropical country of Costa Rica offers more adventures than any other vacation location, and we have planned vacation packages for over 15 years. Choose one of our many adventure packages to have the best vacation ever!

First, explore the exotic rainforests. The Costa Rican rainforests contain more than half of all the living species on Earth! They have more different plant species than all of Europe. Walk through the jungle on hanging bridges so that you can see all of the plant and animal life close up.

Then hold on tight to your zip line, or rope, as you fly through the jungle 120 feet (40 meters) above the ground. Choose your speed. You can move slowly through the trees to see everything as you pass by, or, if you are looking for excitement, fly as fast as the wind. You can even take your zip line down a 40-foot (12-meter) waterfall. Splash into the water below as the waterfall comes down on top of you.

Next, hike to the top of a rumbling volcano. Costa Rica has over 200 volcanoes, and about 100 of them show activity. Five of the volcanoes are active. They shoot out water, steam, and sometimes fire as you watch.

Finally, if you need more adventure than this, there is also white-water rafting and canoeing. The Pacuare River has been called the best white water in Latin America. Raft 18 miles (29 kilometers) through the rainforest and enjoy the excitement and scenery.
