1 - نضيف **es** للأفعال المنتهية بالحروف الاتية **ch / sh / ss / o / x** مثل:

watch **watches** wash **washes** cross **crosses** go **goes** fix **fixes**

2

– نضيف **ies** للأفعال المنتهية بـ **y** و يسبقها حرف ساكن مثل:

cry **cries** try **tries** study **studies**

3

– نضيف **s** لباقي الافعال التي لا ينطبق عليها ما سبق مثل:

drive **drives** sleep **sleeps** play **plays**

للسؤال نستخدم **don't / doesn't** قبل الفعل مع حذف الإضافات إن وجدت مثل:

He **plays** football.

He **doesn't play** football.

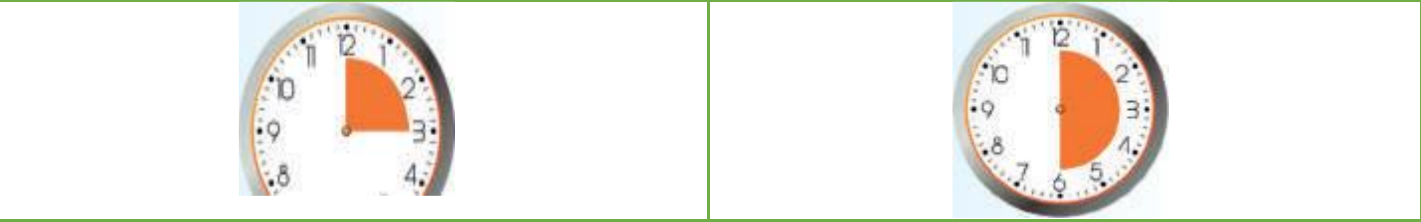



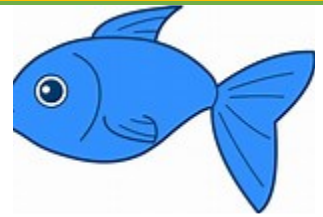
