- 1) The first Oxford and Cambridge Boat Race was held at Henley-on-Thames in 1829. That's when two old school friends, Charles Wordsworth, who went to Oxford University, and Charles Merrivale, who went to Cambridge University, decided to challenge each other to a boat race. Oxford won the race easily and the winning boat is on display at the River & Rowing Museum in Henley.
- 2)The race has been held annually since then, except during the two World Wars and the COVID-19 pandemic. The loser of the race traditionally challenges the winner to a re-match every year. The race takes place on the River Thames in London, where it is a tradition for the universities to compete in a demanding four-mile rowing race. With each team celebrating an impressive number of wins, the competition between the Oxford and Cambridge universities remains very strong.
