- We use the past simple for the completed action.

Example:

"I was watching TV when somebody knocked at the door."

When + Past Simple, Past Continuous

(V²) was / were + ing

OR:





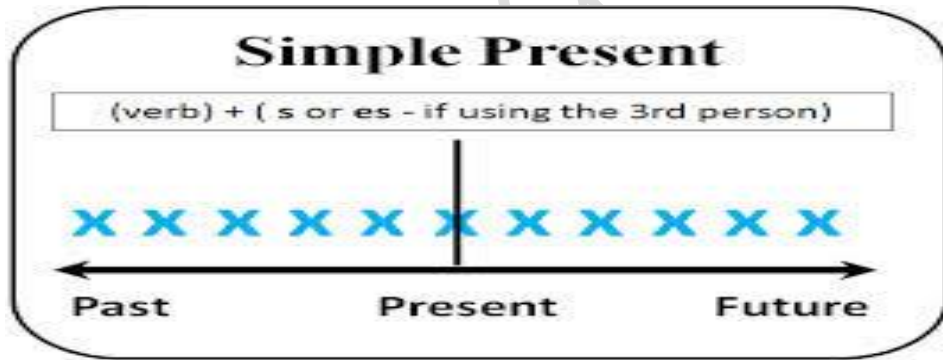
