





If you have ever confidently walked into a room only to forget why you went there in the first place, then you will understand that human memory is full of surprises. We seem to forget important information yet remember thousands of daily details we will never need. Why is this the case?

There is no limit to the amount of information you can remember. Given how much we seem to forget on a daily basis, it may seem <u>strange</u> but it is completely true that our brains have an essentially unlimited storage capacity for learning. A rough calculation by Paul Rober, a professor of psychology suggests that our brain can store 2,500,000 Gigabytes. So if we have an unlimited storage capacity, why do we still forget too much? A lot of evidence suggests that we are more likely to remember something if we make an active effort to understand it, and if we encounter it regularly- as this strengthens the connection between neurons in the brain and makes information easier to remember.

It is easy to think of our brains as kind of digital recorder for information <u>which</u> can turn on and off when we are reading, listening or watching something. Unfortunately, human memory doesn't work like that. Information related to the memory are stored in the area of the brain they first came in. Visual information stay in one area, listening information in another, familiar names go to another and so on.



Floods are regarded as the most common of all disasters. They take place everywhere in the world, resulting in widespread damage or even death. As a result, scientists have long tried to predict floods. There are many conditions, from deep snow on the ground to human error, that cause flood.

When deep snow melts it creates a large amount of water. When it <u>occurs</u> together with heavy rain and sudden warmer weather it can lead to serious flooding. Melting snow also contributes to high water levels in rivers and dams. Whenever rivers are already at their full capacity of water, heavy rain will result in the rivers flooding. Rivers that are covered with ice can lead to flooding. When ice begins to melt the surface of the ice cracks and breaks into large pieces. These pieces of ice move and float down the river. They can form a dam in the river, causing the water behind the dam to rise and flood the land.

When a large human-made dam breaks or fails to hold water collected behind it, the results can be devastating. Dam waters can travel tens of kilometres and cover the ground in metres of mud and water.

Although scientists can't always predict exactly when floods will occur, <u>they</u> do know a great deal about when floods are likely, or probably, going to occur. Deep snow, ice-covered rivers and weak dams are all strong conditions for potential flooding. Hopefully, this knowledge of why floods happen can help us reduce the damage they cause.




