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Subject + verb + object

He, She, It verb + s

We, you, they, I verb
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Examples:

- 2. She <u>always</u> <u>wears</u> beautiful earrings in her ears.
- 3. They go to the stadium every week to watch the match.
- 4. Butterfly is an amazing insect. It has beautiful colours.

Past simple


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Something happened in the past.

The future simple (I'm going to) التخطيط للمستقبل





Key words: (tomorrow - next)
