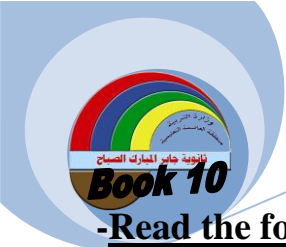

food in order to produce the forces which keep the heart beating, the lungs breathing and the limbs moving. But the discovery of vitamins at the turn of the present century has 'rediscovered' the science of nutrition. Since then great advances have been made in the field of nutrition. Nutrition on the other hand, signifies a dynamic process in which the food that is consumed is utilized for nourishing the body.
