VI- Reading Comprehension (110 Marks)

Read the following passage carefully, and then answer the questions below:

[1] A British eco-friendly family have reduced their household waste so much. They have only filled one bin - in six months. The Strauss throw away an average of just 100 g of litter every week - enough to fit in the palm of a hand. They do not buy anything with packaging, recycle everything they can, compost all their **leftover** food and buy vegetables direct from local farmers. The family even take their own containers to their butcher to collect meat, so they do not use any packaging or plastic. Even at parties, when the average family throw out an extra five bags of rubbish, the Strauss family throw away just 78 g of litter.

[2] Rachele, 36, has now set herself the target of throwing out just one bin of rubbish in the whole of 2009. But she insists they are just a 'normal family who have fun like anyone else'. She said: "People assume we have boring parties, but it's just not true. They associate fun with waste, but that's rubbish. Our table is groaning with great food, but it is home made with meat and vegetables from the local farm."

[3] Rachele and husband Richard, 52, who have a seven-year-old daughter Verona, started recycling last March by cutting down on their use of plastic. Rachele said: "It all started when we watched a TV programme about the damage to marine life being caused by plastic contamination. I'd been thinking about the idea of recycling our waste for a couple of years, but seeing those pictures of birds and turtles with plastic in their stomachs gave us the push we needed to recycle seriously."

[4] The family have a website, www.myzerowaste.com. The site details their recycling secrets and attracts over 70,000 visitors per month. Each Wednesday, Mrs Strauss details to **them** exactly what the family is throwing away piece-by-piece in a weekly 'weigh-in' section of their blog.

[5] Rachele said: "Our daughter, Verona, is really receptive to recycling and she's fascinated by trees and animals and the environment. She picks things up in the supermarket and looks at the packaging to see if it can be recycled. If we go over our 100 g target at the weigh-in, she's the first to tell us off!"

[6] Husband Richard added: "When we started this, I promised not to take another plastic bag from a supermarket and I haven't. We just try to buy food packaged with recyclable or reusable materials. We are planning to go a full year creating the minimum amount of waste and hopefully this will amount to no more than one bin.

A lot of people ignore how to reduce their stress levels. Doctors would recommend that we should swap caffeinated drinks for water. The aim is to keep ourselves hydrated. This will enable our bodies to cope with stress. They also insist on engaging in daily physical activity. Physical exercise can be used as a surrogate to metabolise the excessive stress hormones and restore our bodies and mind to a calmer and more relaxed state. Lack of sleep is a significant cause of stress. Deep sleep requires sufficient time for brain to calm down. Even just talking to someone about how one feels can be helpful.
