It is most necessary for everybody to cut down on his food expenses. Since the early 1970s, the cost of food has gone up faster than the cost of all other items and services. The increase has amounted to more than 300%. For all families in poor countries, food is the biggest item in their monthly household budget. In fact, it swallows more than half the budget of millions of low-income families. People suffer a lot from the high prices of food. How will such a state of affairs end? Is it the fate of low-income families to face starvation?

Isn't there a way out? To be sure, there is. You can reduce your food expenses at least 20% by observing the following pieces of advice. Note the food items which you need when your supplies run low.
